Aim

The Activity Requirement (Racially Motivated Offending) is a specified activity designed to assist offenders to change their attitude and behaviours towards those of a different race. The aim of the Requirement is to challenge accepted negative values, attitudes and behaviour and to ensure offenders give respect to others irrespective of their race or ethnicity. It seeks to prevent offenders from committing a further racially motivated offence.

Suitability

- For offenders aged 18 or over a Standard Delivery Report must be prepared and they must be assessed as suitable by the Probation Service
- For offenders who have committed a racially motivated offence
- The Activity Requirement (Racially Motivated Offending) will normally be part of an Order where supervision is also a requirement

The offender will:

- be supervised in accordance with Probation Service National Standards
- attend at least 15 structured sessions, each up to two hours in duration.
- be required to attend all appointments offered and behave in a pro-social manner at all times
- be returned promptly to Court for failure to comply
