BUNBURY HOUSE PLAYS HOST TO JUDGES

Cheshire Judges paid a visit to Bunbury House Approved Premise, Stanney Grange during June, at the invitation of the Cheshire Probation Area.

Probation staff were on hand to talk about their work in supervising residents of the hostel. The Judges were given a tour of the building and grounds and viewed a new gardening project which residents are actively involved in. The Judges also had the opportunity to meet with the hostel's residents and learnt first hand about life as a resident of Bunbury House.

Bunbury House caters for up to 22 male residents aged 18 years and over, who are on a Court Order with a condition of residence, bailees, or who have been released from prison subject to specific Licence conditions.
